

1. Sin is Lawlessness

Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness.

1 John 3:4

2. Sin comes from within

He went on: "What comes out of a person is what defiles them. For it is from within, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come -- sexual immorality, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. All these evils come from inside and defile a person."

Mark 7:20-23

3. Sin is humanly incurable

The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God.

Romans 8:7-8

4. The Pharisees redefined sin

He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written:

"These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are merely human rules.'

You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to human traditions."
