FAMILY CHALLENGE for Parents

What did your children discover today? They learned God is perfect and we should obey Him. How do we obey God? God gave us the Bible to read so we can know who He is and how we should live. In the book of Exodus, God also gave us the Ten Commandments to learn and obey.

When working with preschoolers, it is important to remind them that good works and obedience do not make us Christians — it is by faith alone in Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:8-9). Our actions are only a result of our faith.

Take the Family Challenge

Each day, listen for the number ten. When you hear it or see it, yell out “God’s Top Ten Commandments!” Reward the person who heard the number “ten” with ten snack items such as Fruit Loops®, M&M’s®, raisins, or chocolate chips.

“Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. The second is this: Love your neighbor as yourself.”

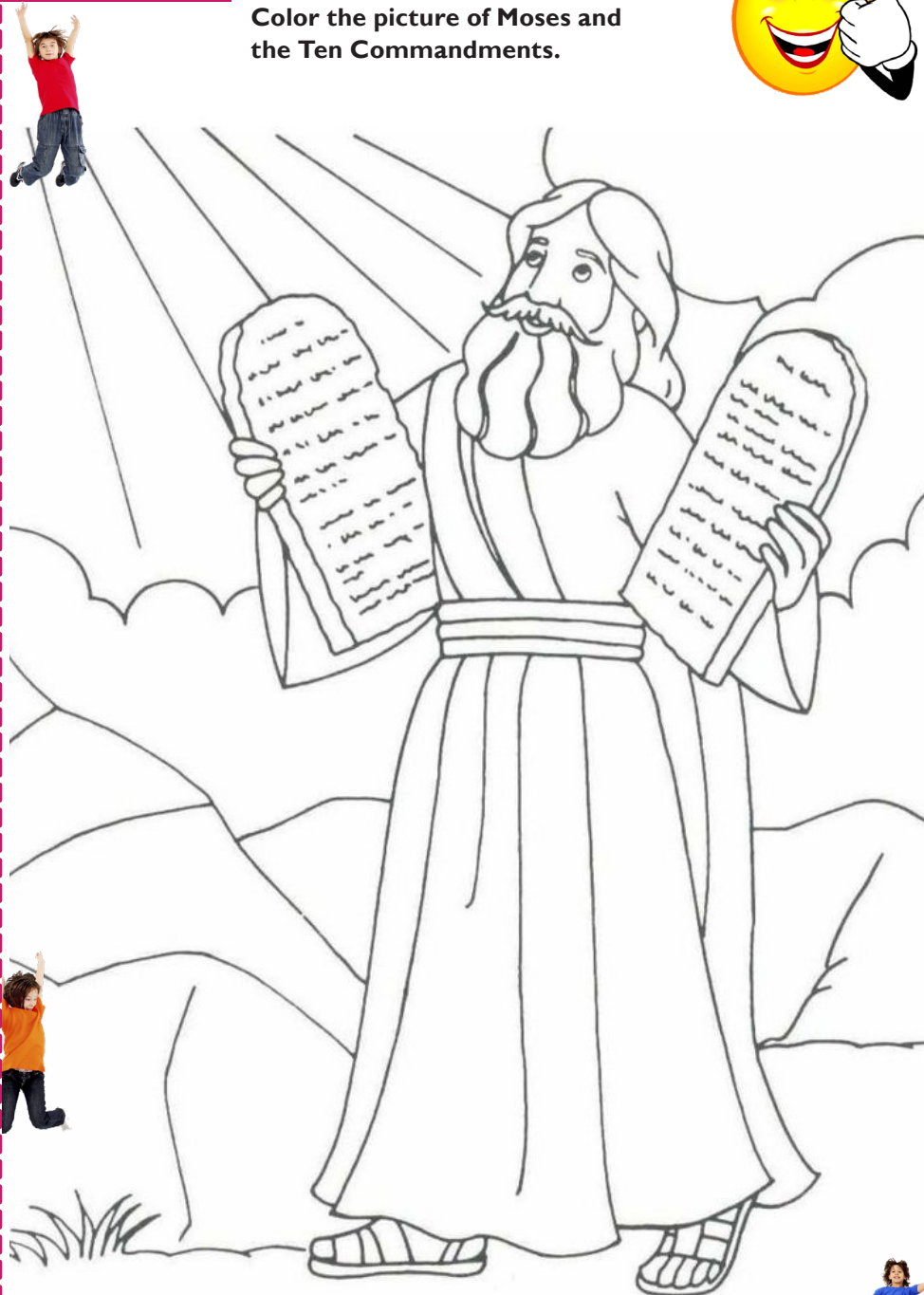
How many “neighbor kids” can you find hidden inside Tracker Jr.?
