FOR PARENTS

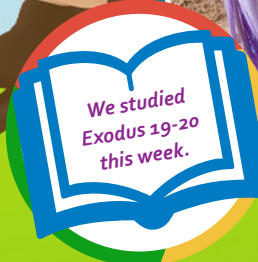

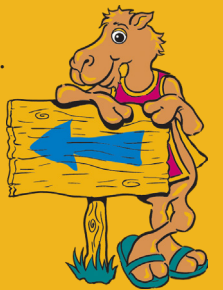
