- 1. Zacchaeus was identified as a wealthy tax collector. How do people identify you in life? (single mom, foundry worker, school teacher, little Johnny's dad, drifting young adult, hermit...) How does this differ from how you identify yourself? How does God see you?
- 2. Zacchaeus gave half of all his possessions to the poor AND made restitution for his dishonesty. What is it that you hold tightest to that you might need to surrender in order to freely live for Christ? (time, feelings, finances, control, family...)
- 3. Zacchaeus was 'found' by Jesus (the Son of Man) at the end of this passage. Can you identify a specific date or period of time where you became a follower of Christ? If not, why not? If you have not surrendered to Christ, what is holding you back? It's quite simple and is as close as a prayer away.
