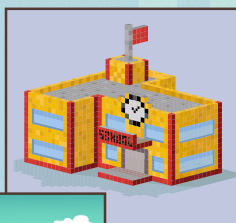

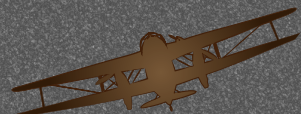
WHERE CAN I TELL OTHERS?

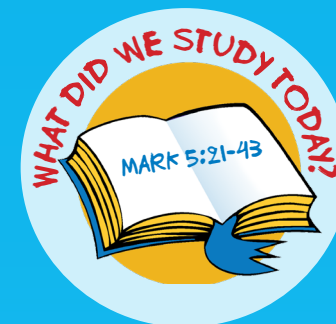
Family Challenge FOR PARENTS

Has your family ever been in crisis — a time where you had to cry out to God and ask, “Where is my all-powerful God?” Today, we studied Mark 5:21-43. These verses challenge us to depend 100% on our all-powerful God, no matter the outcome. If our kids grasp this truth, they will feel encouraged and full of hope no matter the situation. What about you? Do you trust in the all-powerful God? Do you talk to your kids about the trust you have in Him?

Take the Family Challenge

To train your children to stand firm and fully trust God, your family should know, think, and talk about Psalm 147:5 often. Grab a set of sticky notes and section out the verse by writing three or four words on each sticky note. Challenge kids to put the verse in order as fast as they can. If your kids cannot read, add pictures. Time each other to add some competition.

Do you have a high-energy family? Hide the sticky notes throughout the house and have everyone search for the words before they put them in order. Does your family learn better with music? Make up a song with this verse.

- I am asked to do something that is sinful.

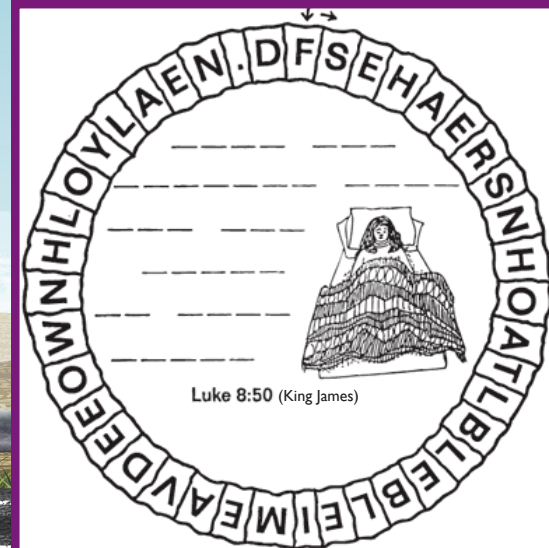
In all these situations, you can talk to God (in prayer) and depend on Him to help you.
